Humility Before Honor

hen thou wast little in thine own sight, wast thou not made the head of the tribes of Israel?" Here Samuel points out the reason for Saul's appointment to the throne of Israel. He had a humble opinion of his own capabilities, and was willing to be instructed. When the divine choice fell upon him, he was deficient in knowledge and experience, and had, with many good qualities, serious defects of character. But the Lord granted him the Holy Spirit as a guide and helper, and placed him in a position where he could develop the qualities requisite for a ruler of Israel.

Should he trust to his own strength and judgment, Saul would move impulsively, and would commit grave errors. But if he would remain humble, seeking constantly to be guided by divine wisdom, and advancing as the providence of God opened the way, he could be enabled to discharge the duties of his high position with success and honor. Under the influence of divine grace, every good quality would be gaining strength, while evil traits would as steadily lose their power.

This is the work which the Lord proposes to do for all who consecrate themselves to him. There are many whom he has called to positions in his work for the same reason that he called Saul, because they are little in their own sight, because they have a humble and teachable spirit. In his providence he places them where they may learn of him. To all who will receive instruction he will impart grace and wisdom. It is his purpose to bring them into so close connection with himself that Satan shall have no opportunity to pervert their judgment or overpower their conscience. He will reveal to them their defects of character, and bestow upon all who seek his aid, strength to correct their errors. Whatever may be man's besetting sin, whatever bitter or baleful passions struggle for the mastery, he may conquer, if he will watch and war against them in the name and strength of Israel's Helper. The children of God should cultivate a keen sensitiveness to sin. Here, as well as elsewhere, we should not despise the day of small things. It is one of Satan's most successful devices, to lead men to the commission of little sins, to blind the mind to the danger of little indulgences, little digressions from the plainly stated requirements of God. Many who would shrink with horror from some great transgression, are led to look upon sin in little matters as of trifling consequence. But those little sins eat out the life of godliness in the soul. The feet which enter upon a

path diverging from the right way are tending toward the broad road that ends in death. When once a retrograde movement begins, no one can tell where it may end

In sparing Agag, the king of Amalek, Saul led his people to feel that they might follow their own judgment instead of God's explicit command. They did not see that their own prosperity as individuals and as a nation depended upon their strict adherence to the command of Him who sees the end from the beginning. God requires us to prove our loyalty to him by unquestioning obedience. In deciding upon any course, we should not ask merely whether we can see harm to result from it, but whether it is contrary to the will of God

We must learn to distrust self, and to rely wholly upon God for guidance and support, for a knowledge of his will, and for strength to perform it. We must be much in communion with God. Prayer in secret, prayer while the hands are engaged in labor, prayer while walking by the way, prayer in the night season, the heart's desires ever ascending to God,—this is our only safety. In this manner Enoch walked with God. In this manner our Exemplar obtained strength to tread the thorny path from Nazareth to Calvary.

Christ, the sinless One, upon whom the Holy Spirit was bestowed without measure, constantly acknowledged his dependence upon God, and sought fresh supplies from the Source of strength and wisdom. How much more should finite, erring man feel his need of help from God every hour and every moment. How carefully should he follow the Leading Hand; how carefully treasure every word that has been given for his guidance and instruction! "As the eyes of servants look unto the hand of their masters, and as the eyes of a maiden unto the hand of her mistress," so should our eyes be upon the Lord our God. His commands should be received with implicit faith, and obeyed with cheerful exactness.

Self confidence is the rock upon which many have been wrecked. The secret of the Christian's strength and safety is revealed in the words of the apostle, "kept by the power of God." In all the undertakings of life, the language of the heart should be, "If the Lord will." We should humbly wait for divine instruction, never going before, or contrary to our, Heavenly Guide.

Would that we could comprehend the significance of the words, "Christ suffered, being tempted." While he was free from the taint of sin, the refined

sensibilities of his holy nature rendered contact with evil unspeakably painful to him. Yet with human nature upon him, he met the arch apostate face to face, and single-handed withstood the foe of his throne. Not even by a thought could Christ be brought to yield to the power of temptation. Satan finds in human hearts some point where he can gain a foothold; some sinful desire is cherished, by means of which his temptations assert their power. But Christ declared of himself, "The prince of this world cometh, and hath nothing in me." The storms of temptation burst upon him, but they could not cause him to swerve from his allegiance to God.

All the followers of Christ have to meet the same malignant foe that assailed their Master. With marvelous skill he adapts his temptations to their circumstances, their temperament, their mental and moral bias, their strong passions. He is ever whispering in the ears of the children of men, as he points to worldly pleasures, gains, or honors, "All this will I give you, if you will do my bidding." We must look to Christ; we must resist as he resisted; we must pray as he prayed; we must agonize, as he agonized, if we would conquer as he conquered.

Whatever the position in which God has placed us, whatever our responsibilities or our dangers, we should remember that he has pledged himself to impart needed grace to the earnest seeker. Those who feel insufficient for their position, and yet accept it because God bids them, relying upon his power and wisdom, will go on from strength to strength. When



they enter upon their work, they may have almost everything to learn; but with Christ as a teacher they will become efficient laborers. God does not intrust his work to the worldly wise; for they are too proud to learn. He chooses those who, feeling their deficiencies, seek to be guided by unerring wisdom.

Those who have learned of Christ will manifest in all their intercourse a humble, teachable spirit, ever willing to receive counsel or correction. The Lord confers upon his servants varied gifts. No one person possesses all the qualifications essential in carrying forward the work of God. Hence no one is qualified to act independently in all matters pertaining to the Lord's cause. In the body of Christ there is the same law of dependence and the same necessity for harmony of action that exists in the human body. While no one member of the church is complete in himself, all combined form a perfect whole.

The meekness and humility of Christ will be seen in his followers. The grain ready for harvest, bending under the burden of its full, ripe ears, is a fitting emblem of the Christian ripening for the heavenly garner. The more closely he resembles Jesus, and the richer and more perfect his character in the development of the Christian graces, the less disposition will he have to honor or exalt self. With the sweet singer of Israel, the language of his heart will be, "Not unto us, O Lord, not unto us, but unto thy name give we glory, for thy mercy and for thy truth's sake."


THE GOLDEN 100

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ARE YOU COVERED?

ut as amazing as all this is which has already been provided to you for free just so that you can be saved, yet there is more that God and Christ have provided you through this glorious plan of your salvation.

When a baby first begins to stand up, do they immediately jump up upon their feet? No, they go through a period of learning how to stand proficiently without wavering. And they do not give up trying their best until they have mastered how to stand. Those who have children know what I'm talking about. Now, after learning how to stand up, do they immediately walk across the room? No, they again go through a period of learning how to walk proficiently without losing their balance. And again, they do not give up trying their best, no matter how many times they fall, until they have mastered how to remain standing while walking forward.

But even though their early attempts at either standing or walking were far from perfect in the beginning, yet they were putting forth their best efforts to accomplish the difficult task before them, and they didn't give up until they finally perfected each task as they matured. Since we, as parents, could not take their place to either stand or walk for them, we understood their weakness and accepted their imperfect efforts as the best they could do at that time in their particular stage of development and growth, and we were continually helping and encouraging them to put forth more efforts until they finally got it right. This same process of development and growth occurs with those who are born again and have become new creatures in Christ Jesus.

After we have been covered with the precious robe of Christ's righteousness and stand perfect before God as if we had never sinned at all, our first attempts at standing, or walking, or fighting this good fight of faith in our new born again life will be far from the perfect example of what Christ revealed when He was on the earth. Then does God disown us because we are not yet living up to the perfect example of what His sons and daughters in Christ should reveal? No, not at all. God mercifully understands that we are still babes in Christ, and as long as we put forth our best efforts at obeying His will, then, even though we may come short of the standard of perfection, yet God accepts us as still being perfect in the particular stage of development and level of growth we are at in our Christian walk.

But how could God accept us as really being perfect when, after we did the best we could, we still came short of perfection? Amazingly, because we put forth our best efforts and could do no more, then God accepted Christ's perfection on our behalf. Or in other words, Christ made up the difference between where our best efforts ended and what the standard of perfection is!

"For who is God save the LORD? or who is a rock save our God? It is God that girdeth me with strength, and maketh my way perfect."

"...their righteousness is of me, saith the Lord."2

"Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and for ever. Amen."

So on a scale of 1 - 10, if 10 was the standard of absolute perfection, and our best efforts at the time only made it to a 4 on this scale, then Christ's perfection would make up the difference, making us a perfect 10 through His righteousness. How? Because we are clothed in His righteousness, and the Father mercifully does not investigate beneath this covering of the Lamb, but accepts us as being faultless and perfect in Christ "with exceeding joy!"

"The LORD hath brought forth our righteousness..."

"The LORD will perfect that which concerneth me: thy mercy, O LORD, endureth for ever..."

Now this is not talking about someone who stops the warfare, refusing to advance upward, and instead has chosen to sin, because Christ's robe of righteousness will never cover anyone who practices a known sin. But this is talking about advancing upward on this straight and narrow pathway, not walking in our flesh, but doing our best to walk in the Spirit while working to overcome our defects and faults of character. And then, if we should come short of perfection, Christ will make up the difference with His precious righteousness!

"Who shall ascend [advance upward] into the hill of the LORD? or who shall stand in his holy place? He that hath clean hands, and a pure heart; who hath not lifted up his soul unto vanity, nor sworn deceitfully. He shall receive the blessing from the LORD, and righteousness from the God of his salvation."

When we were justified, Christ's righteousness was imputed to us by faith alone. But during the process of sanctification, where we are learning by experimentation and experience how to walk and grow more into a mature and perfect man or woman in Christ, Christ's righteousness is imparted to us as through faith we put forth our best efforts to obey the will of God towards perfecting our character in all areas. And after we have done our best, if we still came short of perfection in any area, God understands where we are at in our growth process of sanctification, and He mercifully accepts us as being perfect in our Beloved Saviour.

Do you realize what this means dear ones? This means that all the way along this straight and narrow pathway which you are walking and advancing upward on, you can indeed be perfect in and through Christ Jesus as you continue to grow in grace! You

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can have the assurance that you are accepted of God as His perfect son or daughter all along this straight and narrow pathway because you are doing your best to obey His will! This should then give you the assurance and confidence that you can indeed come directly before God at any time of need without having any fear of being rejected because you couldn't do a better job at walking at that particular time!

"For by one offering he hath perfected for ever them that are sanctified. Whereof the Holy Ghost also is a witness to us: for after that he had said before, This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them; And their sins and iniquities will I remember no more... Having therefore, brethren, boldness to enter into the holiest by the blood of Jesus, By a new and living way, which he hath consecrated for us, through the veil, that is to say, his flesh; And having an high priest over the house of God; Let us draw near with a true heart in full assurance of faith, having our hearts sprinkled from an evil conscience, and our bodies washed with pure water. Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering; (for he is faithful that promised;) And let us consider one another to provoke unto love and to good works."7

Do you now understand better the statement of Paul to the Colossians about Christ? He plainly stated: "As ye have therefore received Christ Jesus the Lord, so walk ye in him: Rooted and built up in him, and stablished in the faith, as ye have been taught, abounding therein with thanksgiving. Beware lest any man spoil you through philosophy and vain deceit, after the tradition of men, after the rudiments of the world, and not after Christ. For in him dwelleth all the fulness of the Godhead bodily. And ye are complete in him..."

The Greek word for "complete" means "to level up or fill up or to perfect." So dear ones, you are complete, leveled and filled up to the standard of perfection and righteousness in Jesus Christ at every step in this Christian walk—if you do your best and not give in to your past life of sin! The Lord Jesus Christ is your Helper all along that narrow pathway, and He will continue to make up your deficiencies of character each and every step of the way until you become "a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fulness of Christ" growing "up into him in all things, which is the head, even Christ."

Remember, Christ told us that "first [comes] the blade, then the ear, after that the full corn in the ear. But when the fruit is brought forth, immediately he putteth in the sickle, because the harvest is come." Thus at every step you take up this straight and narrow pathway, at every stage of growth and development in your Christian walk, you stand perfect and righteous and complete before the Father through Jesus. Just like with the corn in the husk: while it was growing towards becoming that perfectly formed full corn in the ear, it was perfect at each stage of development because it was doing its best to follow the will of God! The same with our growth and development towards becoming that perfectly formed man or woman in character: we are perfect in Christ at each

stage—if we do the best that we can do in following the will of God.

"But unto you that fear my name shall the Sun of righteousness arise with healing in his wings; and ye shall go forth [up that straight and narrow path], and grow up as calves of the stall."12

"For I am not ashamed of the gospel of Christ: for it is the power of God unto salvation to every one that believeth; to the Jew first, and also to the Greek. For therein is the righteousness of God revealed from faith to faith: as it is written, The just shall live by faith." ¹³

"But the path of the just is as the shining light, that shineth more and more unto the perfect day." ¹⁴

So in the beginning of our Christian life and walk with God, we do not start out on this straight and narrow pathway with a character that is fully formed in perfection and righteousness. But we start out as "calves" or young children of God who are to learn to first stand, fight and then "go forth" in walking forward and upward on this "path of the just." And as we advance we also grow and develop "from faith to faith" and "more and more unto the perfect day" until we finally become a fully mature Christian man or woman who represents Christ perfectly in character. At that point Jesus no longer has to make up any deficiencies in us. But all this is only made possible through the glorious plan of our salvation. All I can say is what an amazing and glorious plan God has developed and Christ is carrying out, just so we can be saved!

So again, how much does God and Jesus want you to be saved? How much do They love you and want you to be with Them for eternity? More than just a tremendous amount—it is truly a stupendous amount!

But dear ones, as amazing as this plan of our salvation is and all that God and Christ have already provided for each one of us, it even goes beyond this. They have provided even more to help each one of us to be saved and not lost.

GOD PROVIDES MORE!

How many of us can overcome by ourselves in our own strength and gain salvation? Not one. Now how many of us can overcome by ourselves in the strength and power of God and gain salvation? Again, not one!

"I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me." 15

"Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure." 16

Now, let's just think about this for a moment. Since God has spent so much time, sacrifice and effort to provide you with justification and righteousness by faith, then do you think that He would just abandon His now newly justified and righteous young child to battle it all alone against sin and the Devil? No way! He loves you too much, and cannot sit on the sideline watching. Also, do you think that Christ, after all the time, pain and sacrifice He has endured to provide you with His precious robe of righteousness, that He would just abandon you to battle it all alone against

sin and the Devil as well? No way! He also loves you too much, and also cannot sit on the sideline watching.

"Now the God of peace, that brought again from the dead our Lord Jesus, that great shepherd of the sheep, through the blood of the everlasting covenant, Make you perfect in every good work to do his will, working in you that which is well pleasing in his sight, through Jesus Christ; to whom be glory for ever and ever. Amen."

So both God the Father and Jesus Christ are actively working for our perfection and salvation. But after all that we have done to both God our Father and to Jesus our Saviour, and yet they still love us enough to sacrifice so much in order to save us, is indeed a mystery!

"Even the mystery which hath been hid from ages and from generations, but now is made manifest to his saints: To whom God would make known what is the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; which is Christ in you, the hope of glory: Whom we preach, warning every man, and teaching every man in all wisdom; that we may present every man perfect in Christ Jesus: Whereunto I also labour, striving according to his working, which worketh in me mightily." 18

Now we read that God "worketh in you" to do His will. But just how is God in you? Through Jesus Christ who is the connecting link or mediator between God and man. And we also read that Christ is "in you, the hope of glory. But just how is Jesus Christ in you? Through the Holy Spirit of truth, His representative.

"Believest thou not that I am in the Father, and the Father in me? the words that I speak unto you I speak not of myself: but the Father that dwelleth in me, he doeth the works. Believe me that I am in the Father, and the Father in me: or else believe me for the very works' sake. Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that believeth on me, the works that I do shall he do also; and greater works than these shall he do; because I go unto my Father. And whatsoever ye shall ask in my name [including helping us to overcome all sin and character defects], that will I do, that the Father may be glorified in the Son. If ye shall ask any thing in my name, I will do it. If ye love me, keep my commandments. And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever; Even the Spirit of truth; whom the world cannot receive, because it seeth him not, neither knoweth him: but ye know him; for he dwelleth with you, and shall be in you. I will not leave you comfortless: I will come to you. Yet a little while, and the world seeth me no more; but ye see me: because I live, ye shall live also. At that day ye shall know that I am in my Father, and ye in me, and I in you."22

"Hereby know we that we dwell in him, and he in us, because he hath given us of his Spirit." ²³

"...the Holy Ghost which dwelleth in us."24

So God the Father works in us through His Son Jesus Christ. And Jesus Christ works in us through the Holy Spirit. And the Holy Spirit works in us through the truth and word of God. So all three mighty powers and Beings in the Godhead are not just sitting

on the sidelines watching us battle alone, but They are actively working in us so that we all can fight this battle together against sin and the Devil.

So it is not just our Father and Jesus that are working for our salvation, but the Holy Spirit as well. And as long as you continue to walk and advance forward in the armor of God, working to please Him through faith while continuing to hold on to and retain the righteousness that was given to you by faith in the beginning, how can you fall or fail to gain the victory? That is why we are to be baptized in the name of all three of these Mighty Gods so that each One has our permission to help us all along this pathway.²⁵

But without the Holy Spirit being in us, then we would not have either Jesus or our heavenly Father working in us as well. That is why the Holy Spirit is called another Comforter besides Christ, and amazingly, He is also given to us as a free gift without cost from the Father.

"If ye then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?"²⁶

"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."²⁷

WHAT KIND OF POWER WORKS IN US?

Now what kind of power do these three Gods have as They work in us? They have divine power! So since we have this direct connection to Their divine power working in us, then how many times can we gain the victory over sin and the Devil?

"Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin; for his seed remaineth in him, and he cannot sin, because he is born of God."²⁸

What represents this seed?

"And I will put enmity between thee (the serpent) and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel."29

Who bruised the head of the serpent or Satan? Jesus Christ—He was superior to Satan in everything because He never gave in to any of Satan's temptations. And who bruised the heel of Jesus? Satan—by crucifying Him on the cross. So who represents the seed that is given to us when we are born again? This seed represents Jesus Christ.

"...thy seed, which is Christ."30

Now before we were born again, we were clothed in what kind of garments? We learned that we were clothed in the filthy and sin-stained garments of unrighteousness.31 Now please bear with me here. The Hebrew word for "filthy" means "menstrual flux,"32 and the Hebrew word for "rags" means "clothing or garment."33 So "filthy rags" literally means clothing or garments that have been soiled by the menstrual flux of a woman's monthly cycle, and in Leviticus it mentions that this bloody menstrual issue defiles everything that it comes in contact with.34 This is a very descriptive picture of someone contaminated with sin, and thus any good deeds of righteousness which they might do could not be accepted by God because it was done while their garments were contaminated by filth.

But once we are born again, these filthy garments are removed from us. We are then cleansed and clothed in Christ's pure and spotless robe of right-eousness, and the seed, or Jesus Christ, is planted within us. Now when a woman becomes impregnated with seed, what happens to her menstruation cycle? It ceases, and so there is no more blood to defile her garments. So in this born again condition, we become, as it were, impregnated with the seed—or we have Christ living within us. In other words, we are united with Divinity.

Now what happens when humanity and Divinity is combined? We learned that "Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin!" So once our weak efforts to obey God combines with the divine strength and grace of Christ, what happens? We will not sin, but we will obey God! So you can see that we could then do works of righteousness that would be accepted by God since we are no longer clothed in the filthy rag experience we had while living in sin and in fulfilling the lusts of the flesh.

"Simon Peter, a servant and an apostle of Jesus Christ, to them that have obtained like precious faith with us through the righteousness of God and our Saviour Jesus Christ: Grace and peace be multiplied unto you through the knowledge of God, and of Jesus our Lord, According as his divine power hath given unto us all things that pertain unto life and godliness, through the knowledge of him that hath called us to glory and virtue: Whereby are given unto us exceeding great and precious promises: that by these ye might be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust." 36

So now, how much does God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit want you to be saved? Well, all of your confessed and forsaken sins are forgiven for free. You are given the precious robe of Christ's righteousness as a gift. You are freely accepted and embraced by God as being His real sons and daughters. You are provided without cost all the grace and strength in Christ necessary to successfully fight against all sin and evil. You are also freely given all the armor necessary to

successfully fend off all the attacks of the enemy. God even prevents the Devil from overwhelming you with too many attacks all at once so you will not be overwhelmed and defeated. Christ even makes up for your deficiencies and defects of character with His righteousness as you do your best to deny your habits of sin and defects of the flesh while obeying the will of God. And, as we just learned, God, Jesus and the Holy Spirit do not abandon you to fight this warfare alone, but They all work together in you providing you with Their divine power so that you will no longer sin, but will obey God in all things.

As if you needed even further proof of how anxious your heavenly Father is that you become saved and not lost, He even hears and answers your prayers to Him before you have even finished saying them—especially those prayers where you are asking for help.

"And it shall come to pass, that before they call, I will answer; and while they are yet speaking, I will hear." ³⁷

So how much does God and Christ and the Holy Spirit want you to be saved? How much do They all love you and want you to be with Them for eternity? More than just a tremendous amount; more than just a stupendous amount; it is truly an infinite amount!

Now dear ones, if you fully understood, realized and appreciated all that the Godhead have already provided you, and all that They are already Personally doing through this glorious plan of your redemption and salvation just so that you could be with Them and together enjoy eternity, what will you be led to say and to do?

"My mouth shall show forth thy righteousness and thy salvation all the day; for I know not the numbers thereof. I will go in the strength of the Lord GOD: I will make mention of thy righteousness, even of thine only." 38

"The LORD is exalted; for he dwelleth on high: he hath filled Zion with judgment and righteousness." ³⁹

Editorial

Gospel Order

"For God is not the author of confusion, but of peace, as in all churches of the saints." 1 Corinthians 14:33.

It is the opinion of the mass of professors of religion, that human creeds are indispensable to the maintenance of gospel order. They seem to think that without creeds all would be confusion in the church. But what is the real condition of the churches with all their creeds to aid them? They are in a condition but little less than perfect confusion. And is it not a fact that creed making has produced the Babel confusion now existing among them? If it has, and it is evidently a clear case, then why talk of a human creed being indispensable to the maintenance of gospel order?

Look at anyone of the religious sects, and you will see divisions of the most unhappy character. And it is a common thing to see members of the same church divided in sentiment and in feelings; and discord and confusion existing among them. It is evident, therefore, that human creeds do fail to accomplish the work for which men plead their necessity. Then as they are not sufficient to secure unity, purity, and order in the church, why plead for them? Why not discard them, and at once cast these things which do not answer the end for which they are made to the moles and to the bats?

"But," says one, "is the church of Christ to be left without a rule of faith?" We answer, that she is provided with a creed that is sufficient. "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness, that the man of God may be perfect, thoroughly furnished unto all good works." 2 Timothy 3:16, 17.

Let us look at the character of this creed. It is "given by inspiration of God," therefore it is perfect. It is "profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness." How full!-How complete is this creed! Why need the church have more than this? Then see its object. "That the man of God may be perfect." With it, he is "thoroughly furnished unto all good works." Then let the church of Christ take the Bible for their only creed, believe its plain teaching, obey its injunctions, and for them it will accomplish the very work for which it was designed. "For as the rain commeth down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater; so shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void; but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper in the thing whereto I sent it." Isaiah 4:10, 11.

We go for order and strict discipline in the church of Christ. And while we reject all human creeds, or platforms, which have failed to effect the order set forth in the gospel, we take the Bible, the perfect rule of faith and practice, given by inspiration of God. This shall be our platform on which to stand, our creed and discipline. This will not fail to accomplish the work "whereto it was sent." It came from above. It has its origin in the councils of

heaven.—Its author is the God of "peace" and order; while the strange confusion of man-made creeds spring from this world, and have their origin in the brains of poor erring mortals. "As the heavens are higher than the earth," so is our creed, which is the word of God, higher in perfection and real worth than all human creeds.

We have no idea that it is a small thing to arrive at, and preserve gospel order in the church; yet the work must be, and will be accomplished. If the friends of Christ, the friends of truth and good order, act well their part, the Lord will help, and work gloriously among us. It will be a work of labor, of care and mental suffering to those who are called to take the watch-care of the flock, who watch for souls as those who must give an account. Such have awful responsibilities resting upon them. O, who is sufficient for these things!

That there may be union and order in the church, it is of the highest importance that those who go forth as religious teachers should be in perfect union; union of sentiment and of action. The reverse would produce division and confusion among the precious flock. He who enters upon the work of the gospel ministry, must be called of God, a man of experience, a holy man of God.

Health Nugget—Vaccines!

Do you know what they contain?

In addition to the viral and bacterial RNA or DNA found in vaccines, there are many other very harmful ingredients which are not calculated to promote health by any stretch of the imagination. Below is a list of some of the main components commonly found in vaccines:

Ammonium Sulfate (salt)

Suspected gastrointestinal, liver, nerve and respiratory system poison.

Beta-Propiolactone

Known to cause Cancer. Suspected gastrointestinal, liver, respiratory, skin and sense organ poison.

Genetically Modified Yeast, Animal, Bacterial & Viral DNA

Can be incorporated into the recipients DNA and cause unknown genetic mutations

Latex Rubber

Can cause life-threatening allergic reactions.

Monosodium Glutamate

(MSG)/glutamate/glutamic acid Being studied for mutagenic, teratogenic (developmental malformation and monstrosities) and reproductive effects. A neurotoxin. Allergic reactions can range from mild to severe.

Aluminum

Implicated as a cause of brain damage; suspected factor in Alzheimer's Disease, dementia, seizures and comas. Allergic reactions can occur on skin.

Formaldehyde (formalin)

Major constituent of embalming fluid; poisonous if ingested. Probable carcinogen; suspected gastrointestinal, liver, immune system, nerve, reproductive system and respiratory poison. Linked to leukemia, brain, colon and lymphatic cancer.

Micro Organisms

Live and killed viruses and bacteria and their toxins. The polio vaccine was contaminated with a monkey virus now turning up in human bone, lung-lining (mesothelioma), brain tumors and lymphomas.

When babies are hours or days old it is impossible to know if they have an al-

lergy.

Polysorbate 80

Known to cause cancer in animals.

Tri (n) Butylphosphate

Suspected kidney and nerve poison.

Glutaraldehyde

Poisonous if ingested. Causes birth defects in experimental animals.

Gelatin

Produced from selected pieces of calf and cattle skins, de-mineralized cattle bones and pork skins. Allergic reactions have been reported.

Gentamicin Sulfate & Polymyxin B (antibiotics)

Allergic reactions can range from mild to life threatening.

Mercury (thimerosal)

One of the most poisonous substances known. Has an affinity for the brain, gut, liver, bone marrow and kidneys. Minute amounts can cause nerve damage. Symptoms of mercury toxicity are similar to those of autism.

"Mercury, calomel, and quinine have brought their amount of wretchedness, which the day of God alone will fully reveal. Preparations of mercury and calomel taken into the system ever retain their poisonous strength as long as there is a particle of it left in the system." Ellen G. White

Neomycin Sulfate (antibiotic)

Interferes with vitamin B6 absorption. An error in the uptake of B6 can cause a rare form of epilepsy and mental retardation. Allergic reactions can be mild to life threatening.

Phenol/Phenoxyethanol (2-PE)

Used as antifreeze. Toxic to all cells and capable of disabling the immune system's primary response mechanism.

Human & Animal Cells

Human cells from aborted fetal tissue and human albumin. Pig blood, horse blood, rabbit brain, guinea pig, dog kidney, cow heart, monkey kidney, chick embryo, chicken egg, duck egg, calf serum, sheep blood and others.

For one to believe that they could derive any health benefit whatsoever from such toxic and abominable concoctions is ludicrous. God's people should have nothing to do with the unclean thing. "Know ye not that ye are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwelleth in you? If any man defile the temple of God, him shall God destroy; for the temple of God is holy, which temple ye are." (1 Cor. 3:16, 17) Those who choose to fill their bodies with the unclean thing will surely become wrecks of humanity. "...For whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap. For he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption..."(Gal. 6:7, 8)

"These poisonous preparations have destroyed their millions, and left sufferers upon the earth to linger out a miserable existence. All are better off without these dangerous mixtures. Miserable sufferers, with disease in almost every form, misshapen by suffering, with dreadful ulcers, and pains in the bones, loss of teeth, loss of memory, and impaired sight, are to be seen almost every where. They are victims of poisonous preparations, which have been, in many cases, administered to cure some slight indisposition, which after a day or two of fasting would have disappeared without medicine. But poisonous mixtures, administered by physicians, have proved their ruin.

"The endless variety of medicines in the market, the numerous advertisements of new drugs and mixtures, all of which, as they say, do wonderful cures, kill hundreds where they benefit one. Those who are sick are not patient. They will take the various medicines, some of which are very powerful, although they know nothing of the nature of the mixtures. All the medicines they take only make their recovery more hopeless. Yet they keep dosing, and continue to grow weaker, until they die. Some will have medicine at all events. Then let them take these hurtful mixtures and the various deadly poisons upon their own responsibility. God's servants should not administer medicines which they know will leave behind injurious effects upon the system, even if they do relieve present suffering." [Ellen G. 

RECIPE—Veggie Cutlets

Ingredients:

CUTLETS

- 2 C. Soaked soybeans or garbanzos. (Or canned).
- 1 ½ C. Water.
- 2 T. Soy sauce or ½ C. Bragg's Liquid Aminos.
- 3 T. Chicken-like seasoning.
- 2 T. Yeast flakes.
- 1 T. Onion powder.
- ½ t. Garlic powder.
- 2 C. Vital gluten flour.



BROTH

- 4 C. Water
- 2 T. Bragg's Liquid Aminos. (Or soy sauce).
- 2 T. Chicken or Beef like seasoning. (depending on the flavor desired).

Directions:

CUTLETS

- To soak soybeans or garbanzos, place at least 1 cup dry beans in about 2 cups of water. Leave at room temperature for about 12 hours.
- If you use canned garbanzos; drain the liquid into a cup and add water to equal 1 ½ cups total liquid. Use this in place of the water in the recipe.
- Place soaked, drained beans in a blender with the water and blend. While blending, add seasonings and blend smooth.
- Pour into a bowl and add the gluten flour. It will become very stiff, and the last of the flour should be kneaded in with your hands. Knead for two minutes. If it is too soft (not holding together in an elastic ball), knead in ¼ to ½ cup more gluten flour. This can be done in an electric bread mixer or by hand. Longer kneading will make a final product that is more chewy and elastic, while less kneading will make a final product that is more spongy and bread like.
- Form into two oval shaped loaves and place on an oiled cookie sheet. You can also place in two loaf pans if you prefer.
- Bake for 50 minutes at 350° F.
- Cool on a rack. When cool, slice very thin (about 1/8 inch) and simmer in the broth for five minutes.
- Loaves may be frozen.

BROTH

• For a slightly thicker broth (which makes a more attractive presentation), dissolve 1 ½ T. cornstarch in ¼ C. water and gradually stir into the simmering cutlets.

CUTLET BURGER

• Cut one Cutlet loaf into several pieces. Place in food processor and blend briefly with steel blade, or grind in a meat grinder.

A TRUE STORY—Matt. 6:13; Luke 11:4

Many years ago, Mr. and Mrs. J went to live out West somewhere in Ohio. The place was very different then from what it is now. It was thinly settled, and the nearest house to their own was six miles away. One morning Mr. J left home on business, intending to return by nightfall. But he was detained, and as the night closed in, his wife gave the children their supper and put them to bed. Evening wore on, and still he did not come. A slight noise at the little window made her turn her head; and there, in the darkness, were two great eyes staring into the room. Terrified as she was, she kept still, and soon discerned that the eyes belonged to a huge bear. Now it is very seldom that wild beasts approach a house. MISSION REPORTS

Africa

Zambia September 28, 2011

Greetings from Zambia.

Brethren, since I left Namibia and South Africa things have been so hard for me that I could not even clear my mind to sit down and compile my reports. The situation with my family's accommodation was so serious that I had to look for work to help my wife who worked to find a permanent place to live. The grace of God was with us and He managed to find us a plot where we have built a small mud brick house. We praise God for this.

On February 25, 2011, I left for W Namibia, where I was called by the brethren to help in the preparation of the constitution for the SDRN in readiness for registration. The first meeting for the ministers in Namibia, including myself, was a great challenge. It could not finish as expected, instead there was a lot of misunderstanding amongst the brethren, and we left the place in tears. Another day was set after a few days of prayer. The great Lord helped us on this day and there was a great change in understanding this issue. Moreover, we reached a good agreement and left the place with a lot of exciting encouragement which helped us in finalizing the constitution. In the third meeting officers were elected for leadership at the national level and a permanent full time minister was chosen, this is brother $K \qquad . \ Brothers \ F \qquad \ and \ F2$ where chosen to be managers in the publishing department. Others took the lesser responsibilities.

This was the second week for me in W____. In the fourth meeting all of the church members were called to look at the constitution and the issue of registration. This last day was a day of rejoicing since all of the church members were happy because they have been waiting for this. The blessings of the Lord were upon the church in Namibia and upon all the leaders that attended this wonderful meeting.

While the registration process was going on with brother T____, who was entrusted to do this work with the government, brethren in W____ provided brother K___ and me with an evangelistic project to distribute the pamphlets from "Let There Be Light Ministries" in the locality of W____. After this project we also had a

good time with some visitors on the three Sabbaths we spent in W_____. The truth of our faith was taught to its fullest until others were able to say: "This message is the truth." Brethren, pray for these souls, that wherever they may be, they will remember the words of life. This project took a week and after that brother K____ and I left for K___ M___ in brother K____'s home area to continue with the work. These evangelistic projects lasted for three weeks.

M there was a lot of work, mostly among the old separated brethren in the SDR home churches. Most of these members had by this time stopped gathering in unity with others. Each family had their Sabbath meetings in their own homes. I was asked to meet all of these families in their homes and talk to them, until by the grace of God we all assembled at brother K 's house on the first Sabbath. The great Lord helped us to speak words to bring unity again. For the three weeks I spent in K____ M_ many families came. The message of church registration brought another division. Nevertheless, as some were doubting this message, other non-members who heard this truth embraced it. During this mission I had to go through a lot of tests of faith and many temptations. By the end of this visit in Namibia, I received another call from the Republic of South Africa to go and attend another missionary campmeeting and present lessons on health.

This was the second month in Namibia after leaving home. I called my wife and told her about this. She answered, "May the will of God be done." As for her, she knew that whatever came my way was God's will. Therefore, I contacted M in C____, South Africa, about my finances. Later, a family of brother F2____ in W___ called and told me they were ready to cover my costs to South Africa. In the first week of April, 2011, I started off and joined brother B U____, RSA. By April 13, 2011, I was in C____ for the opening of the ten day camp-meeting in S____. The long awaited week came. Many came from this country, but we were the only ones from Zambia, with two others from the States. The grace of the Lord was with us and my lessons on health reform were presented

while others took other topics.

After the last Sabbath at the camp-meeting, which was only a hundred meters from the ocean, five souls where baptized. The day of my departure came. We left the T main bus station at 10:00 AM. By 10:00 PM we were at the South Africa/Namibia border where I was told by the Namibian officers not to enter their country because my passport showed a lot of stamps, meaning I was doing missionary work and that I was in their country without a work permit. I was removed from the bus at 11:00 PM and told to go back to South Africa. This was a very hard situation for me and it was at this time that I remembered the days of Paul. I was in the cold for three hours until one of the officers asked me to stay in their office for the three remaining hours. I did not have enough money. I communicated with the brethren in Namibia and RSA. The brethren told me to go back to brother B 's place to wait for funds for me to go another route via Botswana. If ever there was a day in my life when I wept and prayed, this was it. It took me two weeks to reach home. I praise God for the brethren in Namibia and South Africa and also the SDRPA who came to my aid in this trying time. May the mighty Lord be with you all.

Right now I am at home and will soon be reporting more to you on what has transpired after I returned and during our recent camp-meeting. The Lord is leading in Zambia, Solwezi and in many other places. To God be the glory! Your brother in faith,

Uganda November 30, 2011

During the year 2011, I have observed the prevalence of vice and impiety in the world. The sufferings of the human race and even within my own family, the triumphs of the ungodly, the many schemes planned by worldlings; all these are practical lessons to teach us that our long awaited Saviour is soon to appear as stated in Matthew 24. In the balances of the sanctuary the heart of the remnant people is being weighed by these events. We may well ask, "O my Lord; what will be the

However, there is work in W Kenya, which needs our efforts and attention. I have listened keenly to the progress there after I left. It seems that all our efforts are taking a right course. These churches included separated people of different sects who now want to have a defined name and position. Despite the fact that I have been tied up with very painful circumstances since March, 2011, we have managed to press forward in working with about ten churches of the "Remnant Church of Africa" who are willing to register in B____, Kenya, as SDR churches. We have also planned for a united camp-meeting there December 11-18, 2011. In this meeting we hope to come up with a full list of all the new churches now embracing the name SDR. This name has been overwhelmingly accepted by them after hearing our message of present truth, leading whole churches to separate from their denominations, especially from the Seventh-day Adventists.

On November 24, 2011, E held a meeting in B____ to get feed back from what I had encouraged him to accomplish. He told me that it was a successful tour in the two places we had visited. He reported that they wanted \$150 to complete the registration process at both the national and regional levels. I told him that when I join him on December 10, 2011, we shall see how best to go about the registration. I will be meeting him after attending another camp-meeting in K____, Uganda, which is due to start on December 4, 2011, and last for one week. They also requested me to come and help at the camp-meeting which is going to be a turning point for many brethren following F. T. Wright of the Sabbath Rest doctrine. Many may be joining the Seventh-day Remnant, which presents the whole gospel truth.

I have been preparing some lessons for these two meetings, where I will be one of the main speakers of the week. I need a few copies of our constitution and some hand outs of the lesson I am going to present. I hope and pray that our generous God will impress all to have a part in this

Uganda December 27, 2011

The year closed with a number of events and the Lord's servants had a burden in identifying which way to go. On December 11, 2011, I had to travel to B_____, Kenya, for a decisive meeting where our principles of doctrine would be presented.

N____, E____ and I were the main speakers of the week and each one of us was allotted two hours every day to present our topics. Our major topics were derived from the pillars of our faith.

The good presentations made at the camp-meeting in B____, Kenya, resulted in the majority of the church members accepting the name Seventh-day Remnant. This camp-meeting was of great profit to our great movement which God's people are being called to follow. The week was spent by the people learning what God has for so long wanted his people to follow in these last days as they prepare for the coming of Christ. [Rev. 3:20]. The seven days which were allotted to the campmeeting passed all too quickly, and the believers wished to spend another seven days in learning more fully the ways of the Lord. Possibly, this was the fulfillment of the scripture that says:

"And the remnant that is escaped of the house of Judah shall yet again take root downward, and bear fruit upward. For out of Jerusalem shall go forth a remnant, and they that escape out of Mount Zion: the zeal of the Lord of hosts shall do this." 2 Kings 19:30-31.

Several churches were represented from the E Remnant Church of Africa which is now a part of the Seventh-day Remnant Church! We broke the centralized thinking of the Lord's work at E which was built up some years back! Many of them have requested that we start making local home church visits so that a lot more can be taught to the people. I also found out that many more different doctrines were being taught in Kenya than in Uganda, even though W and N provinces are SDA strong holds with a publishing press at K____ B___. Sometime back, it used to be a printing press for the whole of East Africa. I believe that we can continue to share the last message of mercy with these ignorant souls.

Our presentation brought a lot of impressions upon the minds of the brethren in W_____, Kenya. The Holy Spirit led us to use locally printed charts to explain the images which were being described in Daniel and Revelation. This proved to be a wonderful method as we taught the pillars of our faith, the sanctuary message and Daniel and Revelation. E____ and I handled church history while N____ took over prophecy.

A lot more needs to be done to fully accomplish the changing of the name to Seventh-day Remnant. For many years, these brethren have not renewed the Registration in Nairobi to indicate that they are still in existence and continuing to preach the separation message which had started in the 1970s! So in 2006 when Pastor B____, who had started this movement, was baptized by brother N____; a new, fresh light of mercy flashed into their minds once again leading them to take a stand! But since then, not many efforts have been put forward to bring the whole church organization into agreement with our statement of faith! This has been welcomed by N____, E___ and I because it raises the value of the organization as we change the name. It makes

our organization look better to the African government as we spread the message.

We closed our camp-meeting by the brethren announcing a number of other meetings which are going to take place soon, starting in March, 2012.

My prayer and request is that the SDRPA may continue supporting the whole project so that a lot more can be achieved by the Lord's will. Thank you for the support, which enables me to do what I couldn't finish by myself.

My efforts are focused towards seeing that all important parts of our movement, that make us the SDR are established. I have discovered that what the East African governments want to get us recognized as an independent entity is our contribution to nation building! Therefore, a lot of restrictions are attached to the process making it slow as security surveillance must give its final report to the concerned state. However, the doctrines and customs of the world are at variance with the truth of God. The church becomes established and strong only when it is a working church! Our conduct is watched by the world, every act is scrutinized and commented upon. The work becomes great, yet simple for us to do if we would inherit eternal life. Just follow true religion working out the principles of God's law—love to God and love to man. The great and simple work done has been the distribution of a lot of printed material bearing the present truth message. Remarkable results have been realized as many separate movements have taken off in different parts of the country. Now our greatest challenge is how to refine them, using the bond of

unity in John 17.

In my efforts to prepare the people, I have tried to be creative in determining what opportunities provide room for witnessing in various areas of East Africa. I have traveled from church to church calling for unity. The publishing ministry is taking off, providing wide evangelism among the ethnic tribes. I pray that the educational scheme will be carefully considered and will be started. I always print material locally thus becoming a small source of supply for our messages of present truth. We should realize that the world is full of false teaching, and if we do not resolutely search the Scriptures for ourselves, we shall accept its errors for truth, adopt its customs and deceive our own hearts. My main interest is therefore being focused in this area of publishing. My next area of interest is in establishing education, which is showing signs of progress, as shown by E , Kenya, which has about one-hundred and fifty pupils still in pastor B 's home. I have told brother E____, who is facing hardship in K with family members, to take over some tasks at E____. We are to deny ungodliness and worldly lusts, and live a life of righteousness [Titus 2:12] so that we can come to the help of the perishing ones! The world is ripening for its destruction and God can bear with sinners but a little longer! We have been instructing our separated movement in the need of a definite identity, based on the old landmarks of the Seventh-day Adventist pioneers, with a peculiar task found in the great prayer of John 17! [See Testimonies for the Church, Vol. 6, p. 17.] Many movements have come up but have disregarded the special prayer for them! This is a time for all of us to realize this prayer and to gather around the sanctuary as united brethren. For we are living in the most holy period of time in history and God is listening to our supplications while Christ ministers!

Pastor B___ of E___, now blind due to age, is happy to hear organization and order being taught in such a manner and has requested me to be his right hand person in presenting this subject. While I am in Uganda, looking after my family members, E___ has promised to be near him most of the time. He likes to share a lot of the experiences about the separation movement which he has been a part of as early as the 1970s. I keep checking on him and encouraging him in the good pastoral work being done.

On March 2, 2012, D called me to attend the meeting at T K for a big gathering which will bring brethren from Rwanda, DRC, Burundi and Tanzania. Many of these churches have not taken up the name SDR as their identity, vet I feel the burden to press on to be of one mind in faith and doctrine when uniting wide territory. I have always been particular on the subject of unity, which leads to us adopting the name Seventh-day Remnant, and I have never turned down any invitation. Brethren around the region have accepted our message on the same

subject and more so because we are holding the old landmarks of our pioneers, proclaiming the loud cry message of Revelation 18. D requested me to get them a number of booklets, SOP books, if any, and tracts to be given out to different brethren who will come to attend the uniting conference due to take place April-May, 2012. This made me double my efforts in preparing to get enough copies produced in time. I have also told E to get a few copies of SOP at a cheap cost from K , a publishing house for the main stream SDA Church. Uganda March 23, 2012

Greetings to you all in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ! Hope you are doing okay. Down here all is not well, as two persons of our family have gotten malaria. Of these two, I am one of them, and it is due to this that I have not been able to send to you this progress report earlier. Even now as I send it, I am still battling with malaria and chest pain.

Now to get the ball rolling on the issue of the work here, I visited K___, N___, B___, B2___, N2___, J___, and T___. This all happened from the end of November last year, to early February this year. But before I say anything on these journeys I will commence by bringing forward the work in the K___ area through our outreach programs. Issues pertaining to my journeys to those different places I will bring to light in my next report.

From the middle of last year, in the K____ area we embarked on the work of spreading present truth through literature and house to house work. To say the least, this work produced a mixed blessing. In order to start well we had some spirit of prophesy books that had been sent to K___way back in 2009 and which had been stored at elder E____'s place for all

this time. So we requested him to allow us to use them in our work of evangelizing and he obliged. The range of the books, booklets, and tracts we had were: SOP books namely; Great Controversy, Desire of Ages, Steps to Christ, Christ Object Lessons, Ministry of Healing, and Patriarchs and Prophets. Then we also had Sunday law books and the small book in Luganda, which I had translated. In order to get the work of this Luganda book going we printed five hundred copies and each copy cost two-thousand five-hundred shillings, so for the five hundred books we spent one-million two-hundred and fifty-thousand shillings. As we went out to do this grand work, this "Luganda book" was a darling to many, for they could easily understand the language and hence it became a spring board that made all other books to be accepted in homes, shops, markets, on the roads in taxis and buses and also to those who were walking on the streets as we interacted with them.

As we proceeded with this work we met many challenges and blessings. Of the many challenges I will mention but one, which blew out of proportion. I will code name it "THE BURNING OF THE SCROLL." As in Biblical times, they burnt the scroll of Jeremiah as is written in the book of Jeremiah, chapter 36. In the self same manner our errand on that fateful day, ended in the burning of the SOP books, tracts and booklets. This was done a week later at N____ SDA church—the second biggest SDA church in Uganda.

It was on the Sabbath of November 12,

2011, that we at B home church decided after having our lunch, to go and do this work of spreading our silent messengers in areas of B____, K____, M_ K2___, N___, W___ and N2___. All of these small townships and their adjacent villages are in a range of not more than eight miles from our church. We used for our transport elder E 's car. We went out as a team of eight workers, four men and four women, with our load of books. On our trip we made stop-overs in these town centers and then walked out with the books to share with the people the message of life. We went two by two, two heading to the North, two heading to the East, two heading to the South and two heading to the West of these places and beyond into their adjacent villages. We met many who appreciated the messages and received the printed pages with great joy, but we also met some who rejected them, saying they can only get reading matter from their churches. We reached out to Evangelical, Protestant and Catholic churches and the individuals we met there accepted the books. In $K_{\underline{\hspace{1cm}}}$, we went to the SDA Reform church and they also welcomed the good tidings of salvation in the printed pages. They also directed us to an SDA church within the area. When we reached there, we got a few members who told us we would need to wait a little longer, for their pastor and elders, before they could take the books. We had to park our car and wait for the pastor for a good thirty-eight minutes. On his arrival, we requested him to lead us in prayer before we

relayed our mission to him and he accepted. We then put before him our books, and he was both confused and convinced —convinced because it was the first time he had touched the scarce SOP books and with joy he told his flock to each pick a copy. But he was confused as to why this grand work is not done by his darling church and also why we don't first go to the conference head office to get permission from the leaders. In response, I told him we are all called to be co-workers with God to do His services, and should wait for no man's permission to fulfill this commission. To uphold this I read from the Bible: Matthew 28:17-20, Isaiah 6:8, Mark 16:15, Jeremiah 20:9, Matthew 5:14-16, Ephesians 6:14-15, and Isaiah 52:7-9. I also quoted Testimonies to Ministers, p. 300. After sharing with him, I sealed it with a quote from the SOP as follows: "Amid the moral darkness, light is to shine forth in clear, distinct rays... But every soul needs to turn his face towards the light that he may reflect the light." In Heavenly Places, p. 96.

After hearing this, he was deeply touched and requested us to leave with him more materials and we obliged. We requested him to pray for us on our departure but he instead pleaded with me to lead in prayer. After the prayer we left over joyed and we continued to other places doing our evangelizing work.
